1 For telephone and email bookings: Deposits are non transferable and non refundable. £100 per room is required. Once a deposit is paid a contract has been entered into and it will be deemed that the client has agreed with the Booking Terms and Conditions. If a booking is for 2 days or less then full payment is required. For online bookings please see the relevant online provider conditions.

2 Due to our remote location every effort will be made to re-let cancelled accommodation however a charge of 95% of the total cost will be due if the accommodation is not re-let. If cancellation is within 7 days of arrival the full cost will be due. Please insure against such eventuality and any travel delays etc. If your deposit is paid by debit or credit card then these details will be kept securely and in case of the eventuality of cancellation whereby the remaining amount due will be automatically processed. If room(s) are re-let then a refund or part refund will be made to the same card within 48 hrs of the planned departure date. If a deposit is paid by cheque or bank transfter then a an invoice for the remaining outstanding amount will be emailed/posted. Payment terms will be given on the invoice.
